Year Group Student Context

Our Year 11 leavers this year were made up of a cohort of 17 students:

Of the Year 11 cohort, 13 students accessed full-time lessons on site (11 year 11, 2 APT). Of the remaining 4 students 2 accessed a combination of alternative provision and school lessons, 1 accessed alternative provision throughout Year 11 and 1 accessed schooling through home for Key Stage 4.

Headline Data

The points of notice that should be taken from our students' results include:

Overall figures:

- 5.88% of candidates (1 candidate) achieved 5 GCSEs or equivalents at Level 2 (up from 0% last year and 0% the year before that).
- *47.06% of candidates achieved 5 or more GCSEs or equivalents at Level 1
- *82.35% of candidates have left with a qualification in English and Mathematics

GCSEs:

- *47.06% of our Year 11 cohort achieved 5 GCSE passes at grades 9-1 (up from 11.11% on 2022-23 and up from 44.44% on 2021-22).
- Included in this are some good or strong passes (those at grades 4 and 5) GCSE English Language got a grade 5, GCSE Mathematics a grade 4, GCSE English Literature a grade 4 and GCSE Art and Design 3 grade 4s.
- For the first year ever all candidates entered passed GCSE English Literature

BTECs:

9 Level 2 Awards in Home Cooking Skills and 15 Level 1 Awards in Home Cooking Skills

Entry Level Certificate:

All 17 entries passed ELC Mathematics, 14 passed ELC Step up to English, 14 passed ELC Science and 13 passed ELC Physical Education

- A total of *180 qualifications ranging from Entry Level to Level 2
- *95 Level 1 qualifications (or equivalent)
- 16 Level 2 qualifications (or equivalent)
- 100% of all students gained at least Level 1 Qualification (Last Year 100%)
- 52.94% of all students gained at least 1 Level 2 Qualification (Last Year 10%)
- 73 GCSE entries, with 79.45% students achieving a pass. This includes 23.29% of grades exceeding the targets and 24.66% meeting the expectation.
